

# Notes from the Elkesley Parish Council meeting held on 18th Jan 2022

Councillor O'Brien chaired the meeting.

Apologies were received from Councillor Skelton.

During the public session, a villager asked about what can be done about all the moles on the verges of Lawnwood and Headland Avenue. NCC has been responsible for these areas for several years. The Parish Council are happy to let them know as the resident was at the meeting however, if residents see issues with grass and verges in the village, other than on the playing field, churchyard or cemetery, then please report it to VIA on 0300 500 80 80.

Bassetlaw District Councillor, Kevin Dukes, asked that everyone look at the local plan and the addendum regarding the Traveller site and make comments where necessary as this will affect the village. Planning enforcement consultation is now open and can be seen on the council website, please have your say on how the enforcement team deal with unauthorised developments and much more.

BDC also has money available to create Neighbourhood plans, although it's unsure if this funding is for existing plans, new plans or just for trialling the new procedure for neighbourhood plans.

The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed and signed.

Financial details were given and the payments due were made.

Safety inspections for the field have been carried out by Councillor Jefferson and all was ok with the equipment. The only thing brought up was moles again. Councillor May agreed to arrange for these to be dealt with. It was also suggested by Councillor Stronach that the adjacent fields around the playing field could be the cause of the moles. The council asked Councillor May if he could liaise with the owners to see if there was anything that could be done with any moles found on their property.

A long discussion took place regarding the Bassetlaw District Plan and the Travellers site. The survey, which was sent to every house in the village was discussed. Approximately 350 questionnaires were delivered and as of 18th Jan 118 had been returned, and it was envisaged that more would be coming in over the next few days. All questionnaires had been anonymised prior to the meeting and this will be done to all future returns received.

The majority disagreed with having a traveller's site in the village, mainly because of the issues with dogs from the site and the inability to use Brough Lane safely. Vehicles used by underage drivers travelling at speed and the anti social behaviour was also identified along with various other issues.

As part of the collection of information Cllr O'Brien advised the meeting that all previous planning applications for Brough Lane have been rejected over the years and although some didn't have a reason on the planning portal because of how old the application was, several including caravan sites and Caravans for security had been rejected. Whilst there were varying reasons for the rejections all of them highlighted the area in question was not appropriate for development and that Brough Lane was too narrow for the continual use of vehicles. The evidence collected will now be used by the Parish Council to object to the sites inclusion in the Bassetlaw District Local Plan.

It was agreed that a planning consultant be asked to look at putting the objection together and present it to the Parish Council prior to it being forwarded to BDC.

Councillor Stronach asked if there was any external funding to pay for the consultant. The chair advised the meeting she was not aware of any but asked Councillor Stronagh if he would like to look for alternative funding.

### The Cowboy who Conquered the Sky

'The Cowboy who Conquered the Sky' is about the life of Samuel Franklin Cody who was born in Iowa, USA in 1867. A larger than life, colourful character who, due to the similar way he dressed, was often mistaken for Buffalo Bill as he toured England and Europe with his Wild West Shows. However, he found a passion in aviation, and using his practical skills started building man-lifting kites, and progressed, through gliders and airships, to producing powered aircraft. In 1908, S F Cody became famous for making the first sustained flight in the UK of a heavier than air powered aeroplane. He also became a British citizen at the first Aviation Meeting which took place at Doncaster Racecourse in 1909. S F Cody then went on to build a series of aircraft, including one with floats, which he successfully flew at various events up and down the country winning nominal amounts of prize money. In 1912 he won the military trials and his Cody No. Va aircraft was purchased for the Army and handed over to the RFC. In the same year he was awarded the Royal Aero Club Gold Medal, its highest honour for his continued services to aeronautics. In August 1913, the machine S F Cody was flying with a passenger near Farnborough broke up in the air, and they were both killed. The popularity of this "kind, considerate, indomitable and courageous man" was demonstrated by the fact that his funeral procession was half a mile long, and drew an estimated crowd of 100,000 people.

# Watercourses on or next to your property



Watercourses help manage surface water, prevent flooding and improve habitats for wildlife so it's important to keep them clear and well maintained.

Rivers, brooks, streams, culverts and roadside ditches are all watercourses even if they don't contain water all year round. If you have any of these running through, underneath or next to your property it's your responsibility to look after them. The legal term for this is Riparian Ownership.

### What are your rights and responsibilities as a riparian owner?

As a riparian owner you must:

- · keep structures that you own, such as culverts and trash screen weirs, clear from debris
- maintain the bed and banks of the watercourse, including shrubs and trees
- clear away debris, even if it did not originate from your land
- allow water to run through your section of the watercourse without any obstruction, pollution or diversion
- not impact the rights of your downstream neighbour which in turn means that you will not

### What are the common problems that can affect a watercourse?

- Installing culverts/pipes that are too small and create a blockage
- Not keeping culverts/pipes/trash screens clear
- Allowing silt to build up, which can reduce the capacity and block the watercourse
- Failing to keep vegetation under control
- Disposal of garden waste and domestic rubbish, either on the bank or within the watercourse

## What happens if I don't undertake my riparian responsibilities?

Nottinghamshire County Council will give you the opportunity to carry out any necessary work in a timely manner. If the work is not carried out, you could face legal action under the Land Drainage Act 1991. If a road floods because of an obstruction in a ditch, then the Highway Authority may take legal action requiring you to clear it.

### Can I make changes to a watercourse?

Yes, however you must obtain the correct CONSENTS and/or PERMITS from the relevant authorities (see below) before carrying out changes to a watercourse. ### **Further information and contacts**

There are a number of authorities and organisations that have statutory powers over the condition of, and work on, watercourses in Nottinghamshire.

Nottinghamshire County Council is responsible for the management of Flood Risk from surface water run- off from groundwater and smaller watercourses (known as Ordinary Watercourses). As Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA), the County Council has permissive powers and statutory duties to manage and co-ordinate local flood risk management activities in Nottinghamshire.

**The Environment Agency manages** the risk of flooding from main rivers, reservoirs, estuaries and the sea.

Via East Midlands, wholly owned by Nottinghamshire County Council, manages the highway network. This includes gullies, bridges and culverts within the highway. This does not include roadside ditches as they are the responsibility of the adjacent riparian landowner.


