

Gamston with West Drayton and Eaton Parish Council

Notes from the meeting held on Thursday 16th March 2023 at Gamston School.

Meeting

The meeting began with the usual formalities and the minutes from the previous meeting were agreed as being correct.

Highways

District and County Councillor John Ogle was in attendance and the following areas were discussed:

EATON - speeding problems

Still awaiting Nottinghamshire County Council to carry out an assessment via a feasibility study, which should be complete by 31st March. Hopefully then some solutions can be found regarding the problem of vehicles speeding through the village.

The A638 between Eaton and Retford - flooding at the area near to the layby

The Highways Officer has said that the assets have all been cleaned but the ditch at the rear of the layby still requires clearance. The cleaning should improve the problem with flooding but the Highways Management team were going to contact the riparian owner with a view to clearing the ditch.

Councillor Ogle stated that he will be speaking with the HIghways Officer next week and will chase this up.

WEST DRAYTON - road resurfacing

Still awaiting results from the full inspection carried out by Highways.

ROCKLEY - leaning street light

The lamppost has been repaired and this item is now closed.

GAMSTON

Muttonshire Hill

The surface renewal work has now been completed and this item is closed.

A new item has however been raised for the problem with vehicles travelling too fast around the bend and causing damage to the field and boundary fence when they leave the road due to excessive speed. Councillor Howard suggested that the 40 mph speed limit was pushed out before the bend rather than after it to alleviate this. Councillor Ogle agreed, stating that this was also dangerous to any pedestrians as there is no footpath in that location.

A638 at its junction with Stanboard Lane – overgrown hedges.

This area has been assessed by Highways and they state that one years growth is not an issue and that there is no obstruction of the highway or visibility splays when exiting the school. The item is now closed.

Rectory Lane along the river – overgrown hedges and trees

The area around the bridge has now been cut back and this item is closed.

A new item has however been raised, in respect of overgrown trees and hedges in the same location along the footpath bordering the Severn Trent sewage works.

The Chair thanked Councilor Ogle for the contribution from his budget towards a defibrillator for West Drayton.

Members of the public are advised to report any new Highways issues (faulty street lights/ overgrown hedges & trees/ pavement, road & drainage issues etc.) in the first instance, through the 'My Notts' app or online at www.Nottinghamshire.gov.uk
If no action is taken then they should then bring it to the Parish Council meeting for escalation. Likewise, any District Council issues (Fly tipping/ broken or missing street nameplates/ dog fouling etc.) should be reported to Bassetlaw District Council at www.bassetlaw.gov.uk
If no action is taken then it should again be brought to the Parish Council meeting for


